## **Postoperative Instructions**

## For Labyrinthectomy & Endolymphatic Sac Surgery

- 1. Do not blow your nose for three weeks after surgery. If you sneeze or cough do so with your mouth open.
- 2. Avoid heavy lifting (over 10 lbs) straining or bending over for three weeks following surgery.
- 3. Keep your head elevated as much as possible. Sleep and rest on to or three pillows if possible.
- 4. Keep your incision(s) dry for 7 days. After a week you may gently wash the incisions but then dry them completely with a dry towel or hair dryer.
- 5. Avoid travel by air for three weeks following surgery.
- 6. If you wear glasses, either remove the arm on the operated side or make certain that it does not rest on the incision behind the ear for one week.
- 7. Some drainage from the incision behind your ear may occur following surgery. If the drainage is profuse or develops a foul odor please call.
- 8. Some dizziness is common after surgery particularly with Labyrinthectomy.
- 9. After Labyrinthectomy complete hearing loss is expected. After Endolymphatic sac surgery popping sounds, a plugged sensation, ringing or fluctuating hearing may be noticed in the ear during the healing.
- 10. If you should notice any swelling, redness or excessive pain pleases call.
- 11. Please call The Balance and Ear Center, Inc to make an appointment to be seen in 7-10 days after the time of your surgery unless otherwise stated by your physician.
